
Future simple



How do we make the Simple Future Tense?

	subject	auxiliary verb		main verb	
+	I	will		open	the door.
+	You	will		finish	before me.
-	She	will	not	be	at school tomorrow.
-	We	will	not	leave	yet.
?	Will	you		arrive	on time?

When we use the simple future tense in speaking, we often contract the subject and auxiliary verb. For negative sentences in the simple future tense, we contract with won't, like this:

I will	I'll
you will	you'll
he will she will it will	he'll she'll it'll
we will	we'll
they will	they'll

I will not	I won't
you will not	you won't
he will not she will not it will not	he won't she won't it won't
we will not	we won't
they will not	they won't

Future simple refers to a specific time in the future!! "Will" often suggests that a speaker will do something voluntarily. A voluntary action is one the speaker offers to do for someone else. Often, we use "will" to respond to someone else's complaint or request for help. We also use "will" when we request that someone help us or volunteer to do something for us. Similarly, we use "will not" or "won't" when we refuse to voluntarily do something. "Will" is usually used in promises.

Use of will Future

• a spontaneous decision

Example: Wait, I will help you.

• an opinion, hope, uncertainty or assumption regarding the future

Example: He will probably come back tomorrow.

• a promise

Example: I will not watch TV tonight.

• an action in the future that cannot be influenced

Example: It will rain tomorrow.

<u>conditional clauses type I</u>

Example: If I arrive late, I will call you.
